30th Annual Sandcastle Contest

The Rehoboth Beach-Dewey Beach Chamber of Commerce is pleased to host the 30th Annual Sandcastle Contest on Saturday, August 2nd. The contest will be held at Fisherman's Beach at the north end of the Rehoboth Beach Boardwalk, near the Henlopen Hotel, Rehoboth Beach, DE. It is open to both adults and children. Registration begins at 8:30 AM. Judging begins at 3:00 PM. Sponsors to date include, the Delaware College Investment Plan.

Over 100 teams and 800+ participants are again expected to express their artistic flair. Past creations have included No Vacancy, Tower City, Beach Chicken, Hey Diddle Diddle, Dragon's Dilemma, Narnia, Just One Little Kiss, Vacation at Rehoboth Beach, Mack's Ice Cream, 5 Towers, West Kingdom, Lord of the Rings, the Foot, Pirate's Cove, Margaritaville, Bon Appetit, Man Watching Scary Movie with Dog, Poppops's Beach House, Santa Laying Out, Swap Animals, Silverback Gorilla, Mermaids, Pyramids, Crabs, Dolphins, Sharks and of course traditional sandcastles.

The adult and children's divisions each have three categories: sandcastle, animal, and free form. The top three entries in each category receive a prize package. Prizes will be awarded to the youngest contestants as "Smiley's Choice."

NEW THIS YEAR....."Cake Making" Category

This year we have created a category strictly dedicated to cakes in honor of celebrating the Sandcastle Contest's 30th Anniversary. All of the same rules apply as the other categories, **EXCEPT props**, are allowed! The top three entries in this category will receive prizes.

Mission: "To promote business, tourism and civic responsibility."

Sculptures may be started at any time after registration begins and must be completed for judging at 3:00 PM. The winners will be announced at approximately 6:00 PM. Judges are members of the local art community. Entry in the contest is free and donations are appreciated.

Beachgoers who would rather watch than work are welcome. There is no charge to view the competition.

The event is WEATHER DEPENDENT. In the event of bad weather, set up and registration may be delayed up until 10:30AM. If bad weather continues, the event will be cancelled until next year. Any cancellation will be announced on the Radio Station, WGMD 92.7 (945-2050). If bad weather occurs during the contest, participants may continue at will or at the discretion of lifeguards. Judging may be cancelled at anytime if weather warrants cancellation.

THE RULES

The sand sculptures must contain only objects natural to the beach (shells, stones, seaweed, etc.) (This rule does not apply to the “*Cake Making*” category.) Participants must stay away from dunes or any dune grass.

Sculptures may not be dampened or sprayed with any solutions other than water. In other words: NO STICKY STUFF!

Sculptures must be finished by 3:00 PM when judging begins.

Piles of sand must be formed by manpower only. Mechanized assistance is not allowed.

Children’s divisions include ages 14 and younger.

In the children’s divisions, adults are asked not to help – let the kids do it!

PLEASE NOTE: There are no age categories for the “*Cake Making*” category.

There is no limit to the number of participants per team. Participants may not be on multiple teams.

To be judged, creations must be built within placed kite boundaries.
