Sea Witch Festival®: Costume Parade Info

PARKING RESTRICTIONS. Crowd control fencing on both sides of Rehoboth Avenue will be in place beginning on Saturday, October 27th at 2AM. Posted signage will indicate prohibited parking areas. **Abiding by signage is recommended. Police have the authority to ticket or tow as necessary. Parking on Rehoboth Avenue is not recommended.** Adjacent side streets within the City can be utilized for parking.

REHOBOTH AVENUE & STREET CLOSURES. ARRIVE EARLY...before 9AM!!! Rehoboth Avenue will be closed to all traffic on Saturday, October 27th at 2AM and will reopen immediately following the costume parade and fence removal (approximately at 3PM). 1st Street and 2nd Street can be utilized to cross Rehoboth Avenue prior to 9AM. After 9AM, adjacent streets within the City can be utilized for parking and/or drop off for spectators & walking parade participants.

COSTUME WALKING PARADE REGISTRATION AND LINE-UP. Costumed public is welcome to enter the walking section of the Parade and Costume Contest. Registration for the costume parade is donation based and will take place on Saturday, October 27th beginning at 9AM. Registration will be held on the Grub Grocery parking lot at 305 Rehoboth Avenue. (People Only: No pets, livestock, wild animals or reptiles). Costumed parade walkers will register and line up on 4th Street (adjacent to Grub Grocery). The costume parade will begin and end at 4th Street. The parade steps off at 11AM. Mobile restroom facilities will be available during registration and until the end of the parade on the El Jefe Gordo restaurant parking lot at 251 Rehoboth Avenue. (See map on page 3).

FULL PARADE ROUTE. The walkers will lead the parade from 4th Street and enter Rehoboth Avenue headed west to State Street then turn left on Rehoboth Avenue headed east and then turn at the Bandstand to return to 4th Street. Motorized vehicles join & follow the walkers on the parade route at State Street. (See map on page 3).

MOTORIZED PARADE FLOATS/VEHICLES & GROUPS.

A maximum of fifty (50) pre-registered motorized vehicles, floats, and groups of 20+ will begin lining up at 330 Rehoboth Avenue (Lockwood Design & Construction) and State Street at 9AM. Parade motorized vehicles must travel in a straight line only. For safety reasons...candy, beads, etc. may not be thrown from rolling/motorized vehicles, but may be handed to spectators. The merged groups will proceed east on Rehoboth Avenue (toward the Bandstand) and continue on the Avenue westward. The motorized vehicles will continue out of town at the end of the parade and all walkers will end at 4th Street. (See map on page 3).

GRAND MARSHAL. The 2017 Business of the Year, Fins Hospitality Group, will lead the parade followed by the Sea Witch® Clipper Ship pirated by the Ward Family.



AWARDS. Costumed walkers are judged during the parade as they pass the parade judges' stand. Everyone receives a parade ribbon at registration. The top 25 costumed walkers, top 10 motorized vehicles and the judges' favorite bands will receive trophies. **Winners will be posted and trophies will be available for pick up at the Information Table Area after 2PM** on Saturday, October 27th. Winners will also be posted on Beach-Fun.com on the following Monday, October 29th.

PARADE ON TV. The costume parade will be televised live on Saturday, October 27th beginning at 10:30AM on WRDE NBC Coast TV. The parade will be re-broadcasted on Saturday at 6PM & Sunday at 10AM on COZI TV.

PARADE BAD WEATHER PLAN. In the event of unsafe weather causing cancellation of the costume parade on Saturday, notification will be posted to the Chamber's Facebook page and recorded updates will be available at 302-227-6446. **THERE IS NO SCHEDULED RAIN DATE FOR THE COSTUME PARADE.** If parade is cancelled, pictures can be submitted to events@beach-fun.com no later than November 18, 2018 for judging and awards.

Rehoboth Avenue will be closed to ALL traffic Saturday, October 27th from 2AM until the Costume Parade ends (approximately 3PM).

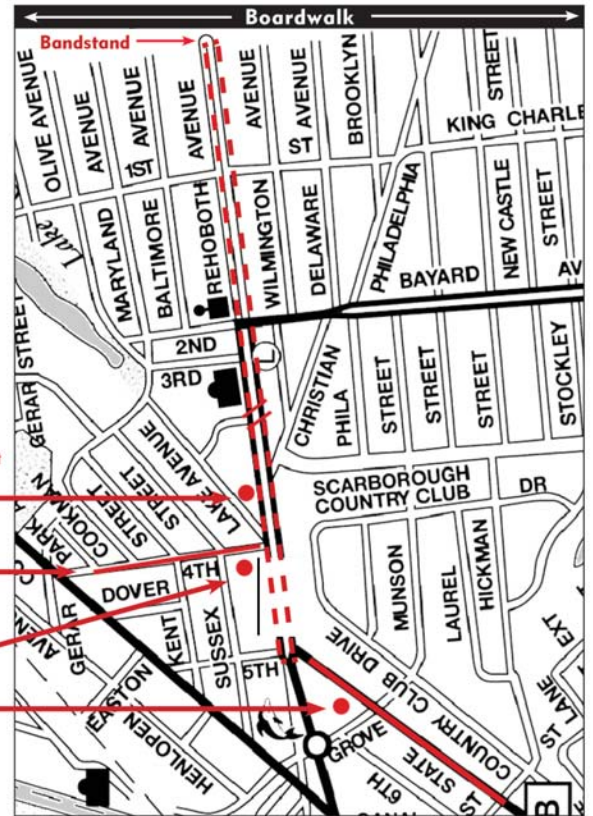

PARKING INFORMATION, SATELLITE LOCATIONS & PICK-UP/DROP-OFF LOCATION. See pages 2-5 for parking information, satellite locations, and pick-up/drop-off location. **For handciap drop-off, use Wilmington Avenue or Baltimore Avenue at the Boardwalk.**

RESTROOMS. Permanent public restrooms are located at the Bandstand & Rehoboth Avenue, the Boardwalk & Baltimore Avenue, the Boardwalk & Delaware Avenue, and Grove Park. Mobile restrooms are located at the El Jefe Gordo restaurant parking lot, 251 Rehoboth Avenue on Saturday only from 8AM until the end of the costume parade.

FIRST AID STATIONS. Sussex County Emergency Medical Services will have a first aid station on Friday, October 26th from 2:30PM-4PM and Sunday, October 28th from 10AM-5PM, which will be located at Rehoboth Avenue and the Boardwalk. There is also a First Aid Station at the Rehoboth Beach Fire Station during all festival hours.

INCLEMENT WEATHER. For information on weather related cancellations and/or postponement of festival events, call the Chamber at 302-227-6446 for recorded updates. Updates will also be posted on the Chamber's Facebook page, plus tune in to local radio stations. Also see schedule of activities on pages 20-25 for activity rain locations. Don't forget to bring your slickers & umbrellas in case of magic rain. There is no parade rain date.

LOST & FOUND. For lost children and/or items, report to the Information Table at the Rehoboth Beach Bandstand for assistance. (Saturday Rain Location: RB Fire Station). Unclaimed items are taken to the Rehoboth Beach Police Station at the end of the Festival.

WINNERS & RESULTS. For contest winners and drawing results, stop by the Information Table at the Rehoboth Beach Bandstand during Festival Hours (Saturday Rain Location: RB Fire Hall). Winners & contest results will also be posted on **Beach-Fun.com** by 5PM on Monday, October 29th.

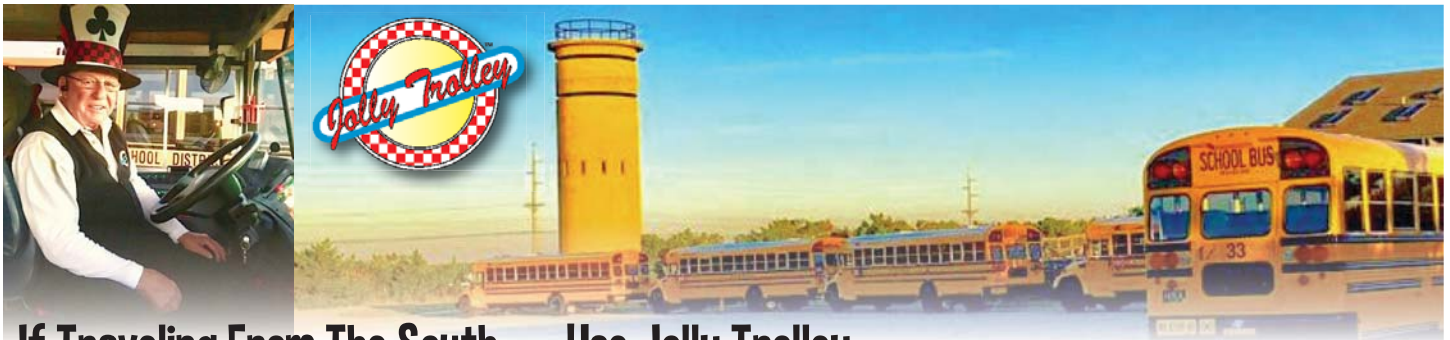
Satellite Parking & Shuttle Service Information



If Traveling From The North . . . Use DART



- Parking will be free at the following DART Park & Ride locations:
 - Rehoboth Beach Park & Ride: Coastal Highway & Shuttle Road
 - Lewes Park & Ride: 17616 Coastal Highway
- Transportation available on Saturday, October 27th from 7AM to 11PM.
- Riders pay \$2.00 for a one-way ride; \$4.20 for a full day pass. Download DART Pass to easily purchase your fare using your phone for quick boarding.
- DART's pick-up and drop-off location for festival goers will be at Lake Avenue by the Henlopen Hotel at the Boardwalk.
- DART's buses are equipped with wheelchair lifts. Service animals only.



If Traveling From The South . . . Use Jolly Trolley

- Parking will be free at Tower Road (Oceanside), Delaware Seashore State Park.
- Roundtrip, continuous shuttles on Saturday, October 27th from 8AM to 8PM.
- Stops located at Original Jolly Trolley Stops in Mid-Dewey Beach and anywhere along event route.
- Adults \$3.00 one-way or \$5.00 roundtrip; Kids 5 years and under \$1.00 each way.
- Jolly Trolley's pick-up and drop-off location for festival goers will be at Lake Avenue by the Henlopen Hotel at the Boardwalk.
- Track vehicles live at JollyTrolley.com.
- Non-Handicap Accessible. Service animals only.

Please Note: DART buses only are handicap accessible. There are no chair lifts on the Jolly Trolley. (There is a ½ mile walk down the Boardwalk to the Bandstand area from the Downtown Henlopen Hotel pick-up/drop-off location).

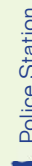

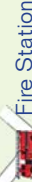
