

Sea Witch® Festival · General Information

PARKING INFORMATION, SHUTTLE SERVICE & PICK-UP/DROP-OFF LOCATION. See pages 2-5 for parking information, shuttle service, and pick-up/drop-off location. For handicap drop-off, use Wilmington Avenue or Baltimore Avenue at the Boardwalk.

RESTROOMS. Public restrooms are located at the Bandstand & Rehoboth Avenue, the Boardwalk & Delaware Avenue, the Convention Center, and Grove Park. Note: restrooms at Baltimore Avenue are closed for construction. Mobile restrooms will be located on the parking lot of Lockwood Construction at 330 State Road on Saturday only from 8AM until the end of the costume parade. Additional mobile restrooms will also be located at the Boardwalk & Wilmington Avenue and beside the Henlopen Hotel through the end of the festival.

FIRST AID STATIONS. Sussex County Emergency Medical Services will have a mobile first aid station at the end of Rehoboth Ave & the Boardwalk on Friday, October 27th from 2:30PM-4PM and a station outside of the Rehoboth Fire Hall (219 Rehoboth Ave) on Saturday from 8AM-6PM. First Aid is also available at the Rehoboth Beach Fire Station during all festival hours.

INCLEMENT WEATHER. For information on weather related cancellations and/or postponement of festival events, call the Chamber at 302-227-6446 for recorded updates. Updates will also be posted on the Chamber's Facebook & Instagram pages. Also see schedule of activities on pages 24-31 for activity rain locations. Don't forget to bring your slickers & umbrellas in case of magic rain. There are no parade rain dates due to logistical, contractual, safety and fencing requirements.

LOST & FOUND. For lost children and/or items, report to the Information Table at the Rehoboth Beach Bandstand for assistance. (Rain Location: Convention Center at 229 Rehoboth Ave). Unclaimed items are taken to the Rehoboth Beach Police Station at the end of the Festival.




Walkers Lineup on 4th Street

Costume Parade Information

PARKING RESTRICTIONS. Crowd control fencing on both sides of Rehoboth Avenue will be in place beginning on Saturday, October 28th at 2AM. Posted signage will indicate prohibited parking areas. Abiding by signage is a must. Police have the authority to ticket or tow vehicles in non-authorized areas. At the owners expense, cars will be towed to Coastal Towing located at 33012 Cedar Grove Road, Lewes, DE 19958. 302-645-6300. Parking on Rehoboth Avenue is not recommended. Adjacent side streets within the City can be utilized for parking. (See map on page 3).

REHOBOTH AVENUE & STREET CLOSURES. ARRIVE EARLY...before 9AM!!! Rehoboth Avenue will be closed to all traffic on Saturday, October 28th at 2AM and will reopen immediately following the costume parade and fence removal (approximately 4PM). 1st Street and 2nd Street can be utilized to cross over Rehoboth Avenue prior to 9:30AM. After 9:30AM, adjacent streets within the City can be utilized for parking and/or drop off for spectators. Participating walkers can be dropped off on Rehoboth Avenue in front of Coho's Market & Grill and Loves Liquors until 10AM.

COSTUME WALKER DROP OFF, PARADE REGISTRATION/LINE-UP & ROUTE. Participating walkers can be dropped off on Rehoboth Avenue in front of Coho's Market & Grill and Loves Liquors until 10AM. NOTE: There will be no parking in front of these locations. Costumed parade walkers will register and line up on 4th Street (adjacent to Coho's Market & Grill and Loves Liquors). Registration will be held on the Coho's Market & Grill and Loves Liquors parking lot at 305 Rehoboth Avenue. The costume parade will begin at 4th Street. The parade steps off at 11AM. The walkers will lead the parade from 4th Street and enter Rehoboth Avenue headed west to State Road then turn left on Rehoboth Avenue headed east and then turn at the Bandstand to return to 4th Street. Walking participants should exit the parade route at 4th Street at the end of the parade. (See diagrams on pages 3 & 4).

Costume Parade kicks off Saturday, Oct. 28th at 11AM

MOTORIZED PARADE FLOATS/VEHICLES & GROUPS.

Balloon Handling Teams: Assigned balloon handling teams should report to 5th Street beginning at 9 AM. Please see parade officials in yellow vests for further instruction. Balloons will be merged onto Rehoboth Avenue with walking participants and bands. Balloons will follow the walking participants along the parade route, returning to 5th Street for balloon deflation.

Rolling Entries & Motorized Parade Floats, Large Walking Groups and Bands Line Up & Route: Rolling entries & motorized parade floats should enter State Road via Canal Street – enter Rehoboth Ave Ext/1A via Coastal Highway/Rt. 1, turn right onto Canal Street, turn left onto State Road. Follow parade official/police direction. Lineup will back up onto Country Club Drive if necessary. Pre-registered rolling entries/motorized parade floats, large walking groups, and bands will begin lining up on State Road at 9 AM. Access to State Road will close at 10:45 AM.

Band Buses should drop participating bands off in front of Rigby's Bar & Grill at 404 Rehoboth Avenue. Band buses should then proceed to post-parade pick up via the following route: u-turn on Rehoboth Avenue at the first median u-turn after drop off; proceed west on Rehoboth Avenue to the traffic circle and take the first right on Columbia Avenue; take the first right onto Sussex Street and proceed to 4th Street (2nd right) for pickup staging.

Bands will be merged onto Rehoboth Avenue with walking participants and balloons. Rolling entries, etc. will be merged onto Rehoboth Avenue immediately following all walking participants, balloons, and band groups will proceed east on Rehoboth Avenue (toward the Bandstand) and continue the Avenue westward. Bands will exit the parade route at 4th Street with walkers for bus pickup. Buses should u-turn on Rehoboth Avenue at 5th Street median, take the traffic circle to Columbia Avenue, and proceed to 4th Street. Rolling entries will proceed westward on Rehoboth Avenue and travel around the traffic circle continue on Rehoboth Avenue exiting at Canal Street where they can access State Road/1B to exit onto Coastal Highway/Rt. 1. (See map on page 3).

GRAND MARSHAL. This year's parade will be led by the 2022 Business of the Year, **Rehoboth Beach Running Co**. They will be followed by the Sea Witch® Clipper Ship which is pirated by the Stewart Family.

AWARDS. Costumed walkers are judged during the parade as they pass the parade judges' stand. All walkers receive a parade ribbon at registration. The top 25 costumed walkers, top 10 motorized vehicles and the judges' favorite bands will receive trophies. Winners will be posted & trophies will be available for pick up at the Info Table Area after 2PM on Saturday, October 28th. Winners will be posted on Beach-Fun.com no later than 5PM on Monday, October 30th.

PARADE BAD WEATHER PLAN. In the event of unsafe weather causing cancellation of the costume parade on Saturday (or other activities during the festival) notification will be posted to the Chamber's Facebook & Instagram pages and recorded updates will be available at 302-227-6446. There is NO scheduled rain date for the Costume Parade due to logistical and contractual obligations. If parade is cancelled, pictures can be submitted to events@beach-fun.com no later than November 3, 2023 for judging. Please Note: Factors that can lead to costume parade cancellation include: high winds, lightning, heavy rain and flooding. Due to the timeframe needed to place parade safety fencing along Rehoboth Avenue, cancellation must be determined no later than Noon on Friday, October 27th prior to the placement of the fencing. Cancellation of the costume parade does not cancel other festival activities.

How The Festival Got Its Name . . .

From the signal tower high atop the Navesink Highlands, that stood 250 feet over the treacherous entrance to New York Harbor at Sandy Hook, the watcher stared out in disbelief. On the horizon he spotted what could only be a heavily sparred ship. The anxious watcher focused in his telescope at the rapidly approaching tea clipper flying clouds of canvas that could only be the Sea Witch, scudding up the New Jersey coast. Her sleek black hull slicing through the choppy swells with the crew at last taking in her sails one after the other and running up her private signal. It was March 25, 1849 and there were no tea clippers due for another two weeks, but there was no denying that there was the Sea Witch



back from her third voyage around the world. Robert Waterman had come romping back from China to New York in 74 days, 14 hours and beaten the tea fleet home. The waterfront was soon buzzing with the news. Within hours a pilot had come aboard the Sea Witch and guided the sleek black tea clipper to her moorings at the South Street wharf. The firm of Howland and Aspinwall would make a fortune at the tea auction and bask in the glory of a new record for the China to New York run. Again William Aspinwall's hunches and daring had paid off in a big way. With profits more than enough to pay for the building of another clipper. New York City went wild with the news of this latest recordbreaking run. The Commercial Advertiser wrote: "The splendid ship Sea Witch, Capt. Waterman, arrived here on Sunday in seventy-five days from China, having performed a voyage around the world in 194 sailing days. During the voyage she has made the shortest direct passages on record: 69 days from New York to Valparaiso; 50 days from Callao to China; 75 days from China to New York. Distance run by observation from New York to Valparaiso, 10,568 miles; average 6 2/5 miles per hour. Distance from Callao to China, 10,417 miles; average, 8 5/8 knots per hour. Distance from China to New York, 14,225 miles; average, 7 7/8 knots per hour. Best ten (consecutive) days' run, 2,634 miles; 11 1/10 knots per hour. "Waterman later wrote: "The model of the Sea Witch had more influence upon the subsequent configuration of fast vessels than any other ship ever built in the United States." 

Costumed dogs only and their humans will parade down the Boardwalk and will be lead by musical entertainment sponsored by **Above the Dunes**. **No livestock, wild animals, reptiles or pets other than dogs are permitted in the contest**. Former bow-wow critters include those outfitted as lifeguards, Egyptians, chickens, cowboys, police, etc.

Participants should be prepared for a 1 & 1/2 mile walk including line-up, parade and return to Rehoboth Avenue from Laurel Street exit. Registration begins at 12PM. Costumed dogs only and their owners will register on Lake Avenue, next to the Henlopen Hotel, where they will receive their entry number and parade ribbon. The registration fee is \$5.00 per dog. Dogs will be judged immediately following registration and before parading. All registered participants will line up at the north end of the Boardwalk parallel to the beach.
