JUST IN FROM THE COUNCIL ON INERNATIONAL EDUCATIONAL EXCHANGE (CIEE)

There is encouraging news concerning new policy directives that relate to Summer Work and Travel (SWT) host employers. On April 18, the President signed the "Buy American, Hire American" Executive Order (EO); the full text of this EO can be found <u>here</u>. Unlike an earlier unofficial draft of this EO that was leaked to the press in January, the final version does not specifically name the J-1 SWT program nor does it set forth specific directives to limit or curtail any visa program. Instead, the signed EO takes a more general approach to the matter, instructing the Departments of Labor/State/Justice/Homeland Security "to propose new rules and issue new guidance, to supersede or revise previous rules and guidance if appropriate, to protect the interests of U.S. workers in the administration of our immigration system, including through the prevention of fraud or abuse." We believe that the changes made to this EO since the draft was leaked reflect a greater understanding of the important cultural exchange and the diplomacy objectives that the J-1 SWT program achieves. We also believe that the final EO reflects appreciation for the seasonal and short-term nature of the jobs that SWT participants take and the fact that they fill labor gaps in our economy and do not displace American workers. While the scope of the directed review is not known, we will monitor the situation, relay details as they are released and continue to pursue advocacy efforts with both the Administration and Congress.
