DELDOT PUBLIC WORKSHOP – CANAL BRIDGES

The Delaware Department of Transportation (DelDOT) will host a public workshop on Tuesday, July 25, 2017. DelDOT officials will be discussing plans to renovate the Rehoboth Drawbridge on Rehoboth Avenue and the Lewes Drawbridge on Savannah Road. The event will run from 4 p.m. until 7 p.m. at the Cape Henlopen High School cafeteria/atrium located at 1250 Kings Highway in Lewes. The workshop will present details of the anticipated schedule and impacts of the upcoming projects on vehicular, pedestrian, and vessel traffic. The upgrades and repairs to the electrical, mechanical, and structural systems of the bridges are vital to extending their viability. In addition to sharing their opinions and concerns at the workshop, the public is also invited to express their views in writing.
