STORM RELATED - FROM THE SUSSEX COUNTY OFFICE OF EMERGENCY OPERATIONS

A low pressure system will rapidly intensify off the Virginia Capes tonight and move quickly to the northeast Tuesday. Strong wind gusts are expected along the coast, which could result in minor beach erosion along the MD and VA coasts. Minor coastal flooding is possible along the MD coast and inland bays. Much colder air enters the region Tuesday night into Wednesday along with the potential for a few lingering snow showers on the Eastern Shore.
