CHAMBER SPRING SIDEWALK SALES – FRIDAY, MAY 16- SUNDAY, MAY 18

Rules and Regulations - City of Rehoboth Beach Merchants - There is no registration required to participate in the annual sidewalk sales; however City of Rehoboth Beach merchants must observe the following rules & regulations:

- Sidewalk sales are specifically for City of Rehoboth Beach businesses that own, operate, and are licensed to do business at their respective storefronts.
- All tables, chairs, etc. should be removed from the sidewalks by 9:00 PM.
- Licensed merchants shall set up directly in front of their business store front.
- The business entrance must be clear and open to public.
- Pedestrian walkways must be open to public.
- Tents are not permitted.
- Restaurants may set up and sell food directly in front of their business provided they adhere to all related Department of Health regulations. **NOTE:** In the past, the Chamber of Commerce and Rehoboth Beach City Manager were made aware that vendors who do not own or operate a business with store frontage in the City of Rehoboth Beach set up sale areas during the Annual Sidewalk Sale time frames. The Rehoboth Beach enforcement officer has been made aware of the situation. Merchants located outside of the City of Rehoboth Beach are required to follow the regulations in their respective locality
