DNREC PUBLIC HEARING TONIGHT - WASTEWATER PROJECTS

The Delaware Dept. of Natural Resources and Environmental Control will hold a public hearing **TONIGHT**, **Tuesday**, **Nov. 15**, **2016** on several wastewater projects proposed by the City of Rehoboth Beach, including the city's ocean outfall. The hearing will begin at 6 PM at Rehoboth Elementary School, 500 Stockley Street, Rehoboth Beach.

PUBLIC WORKSHOP – JUNCTION AND BREAKWATER TRAIL EXTENSON – REHOBOTH AVENUE

The Delaware Dept. of Transportation, in conjunction with the City of Rehoboth Beach, invites the public to a workshop on **December 14, 2016** from 4:00–7:00 PM at the Rehoboth Beach Fire Hall, 219 Rehoboth Avenue, 2nd Floor Mtg. Room, to review/comment on a proposed multi-use trail connecting the existing Junction and Breakwater Trail into Rehoboth Beach, along Rehoboth Avenue, around Grove Park to Henlopen Ave. This project includes a new 10' wide multi-use pathway, crosswalks, and curb ramps and will provide an update on the project's schedule. Interested persons are invited to express their views in writing, giving reasons for, or in opposition to, the proposed project.
