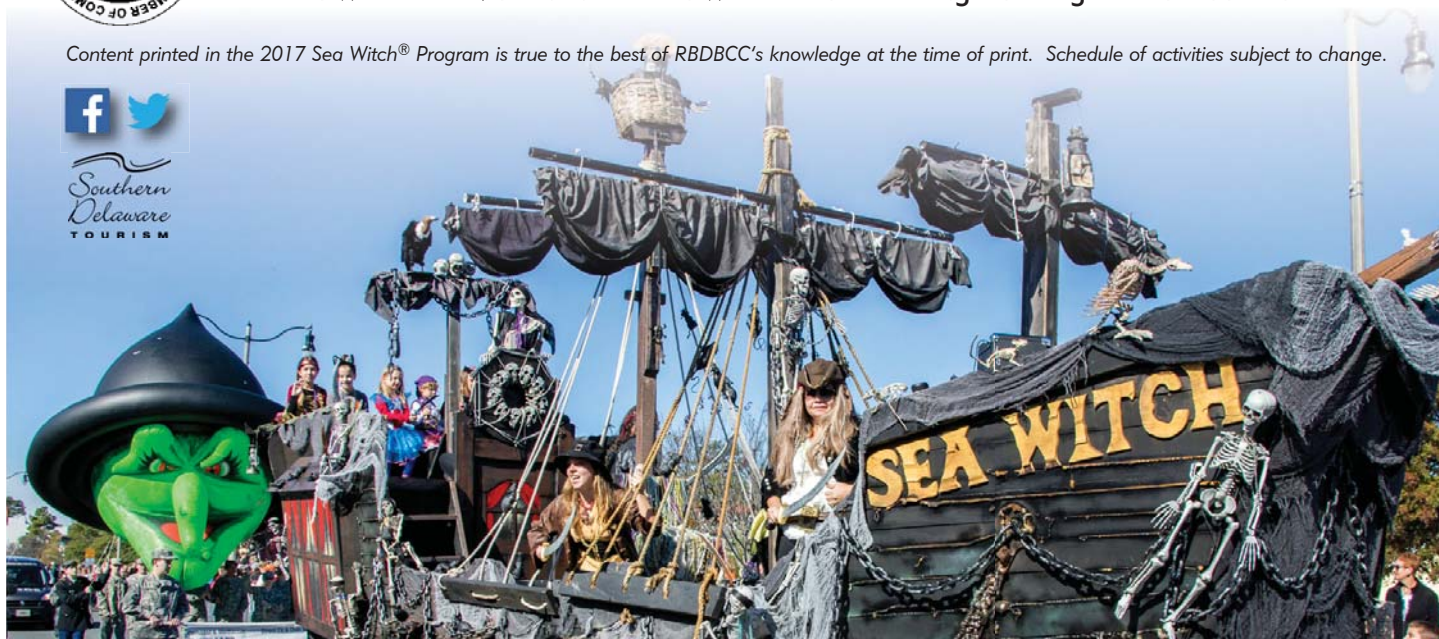

Costume Parade kicks off Saturday, Oct. 28th at 11AM

Sea Witch Festival®: Costume Parade Info

PARKING RESTRICTIONS. Crowd control fencing on both sides of Rehoboth Avenue will be in place beginning on Friday, October 27th at 11PM on the median side & Saturday, October 28th at 4AM on the sidewalk side on Rehoboth Avenue.

- **Rehoboth Avenue, Median:** crowd control fencing will prohibit parking in certain median areas.
- **Rehoboth Avenue, Sidewalk Side:** any vehicles parked on the sidewalk side will be fenced in until after the parade.
- **4th Street for Costume Parade Registration & Line-Up:** some parking restrictions.

REHOBOTH AVENUE CLOSURE. ARRIVE EARLY... 9AM or earlier!!! Rehoboth Avenue will be closed to all traffic on Saturday, October 28th at 10AM and will reopen immediately following the costume parade (approximately at 3PM). \$1 or donation (cash collected as riders board shuttle to return to satellite parking locations) shuttle service to the Downtown Rehoboth Beach drop-off/pick-up location at Lake Avenue at the north end of the Boardwalk by the Henlopen Hotel will operate on Saturday only, October 28th from 8AM - 8PM.

COSTUME WALKING PARADE REGISTRATION AND LINE-UP. Costumed public is welcome to enter the walking section of the Parade and Costume Contest. The parade is donation based. Registration for the costume parade will take place on Saturday, October 28th beginning at 9AM. Registration will be held on the Grub Grocery parking lot at 305 Rehoboth Avenue. (People Only: No pets, livestock, wild animals or reptiles). Costumed parade walkers will register and line up on 4th Street (adjacent to Grub Grocery). The costume parade will begin and end at 4th Street. The parade steps off at 11AM. Mobile restroom facilities will be available during registration and until the end of the parade on the Beachside Bar & Grill parking lot at 251 Rehoboth Avenue. (See map on page 3).

FULL PARADE ROUTE. The walkers will lead the parade from 4th Street and enter Rehoboth Avenue headed west to State Street then turn left on Rehoboth Avenue headed east, turn at the Bandstand to return to 4th Street. Motorized vehicles join & follow the walkers on the parade route at State Street. (See map on page 3).

MOTORIZED PARADE FLOATS/VEHICLES & GROUPS.

A maximum of fifty (50) pre-registered motorized vehicles, floats, and groups of 20+ will begin lining up at 330 Rehoboth Avenue and State Street at 9AM. Pre-registered entries will follow the walkers. For safety reasons...candy, beads, etc. may not be thrown from rolling/motorized vehicles, but may be handed to spectators. The merged groups will proceed east on Rehoboth Avenue (toward) the Bandstand and continue on the Avenue westward. The motorized vehicles will continue out of town at the end of the parade. (See map on page 3).

GRAND MARSHALS. The parade will be lead by the 2016 Business of the Year, Seaboard Hotels & the Simpler Family and the Sea Witch® Clipper Ship pirated by the Ward Family.



AWARDS. Costumes are judged during the parade as they pass the parade judges' stand. Everyone receives a parade ribbon at registration. The top 25 costumed, top 10 motorized and judges' favorite bands will receive trophies. **Winners will be posted at the Information Table Area after 2PM** on Saturday, October 28th and on [www. Beach-Fun.com](http://www.Beach-Fun.com) on the following Monday, October 30th.

PARADE ON TV. The costume parade will be televised live on Saturday, October 28th beginning at 10:30AM on WRDE NBC Coast TV. The parade will re-broadcast on Saturday at 6PM & Sunday at 10AM on COZI TV.

PARADE BAD WEATHER PLAN. In the event of unsafe weather, causing cancellation of the costume parade on Saturday, a costumed walkers parade only will be held at 11AM on Sunday, October 29th on the Boardwalk. **ONLY WALKING PARTICIPANTS** who can meet the requirements of the Boardwalk size, safety, etc. may participate in the costume walking parade. Registration and Line-Up is at the north end of the Boardwalk by the Henlopen Hotel. The costume walking parade will proceed down the Boardwalk and disperse at the Bandstand. **THERE IS NO SCHEDULED RAIN DATE OR LOCATION FOR FLOATS OR MOTORIZED VEHICLES.**

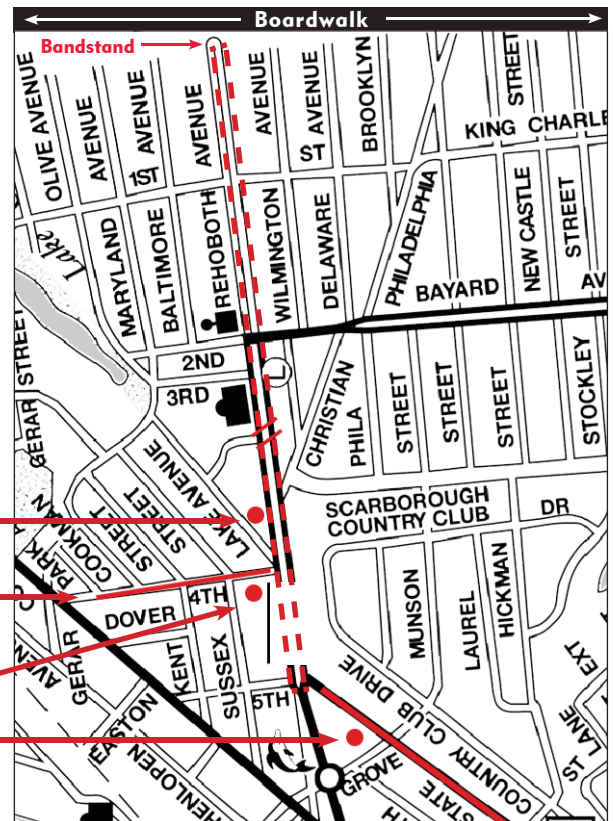

PARKING INFORMATION, SATELLITE LOCATIONS & PICK-UP/DROP-OFF LOCATION. See pages 2-5 for parking information, satellite locations, and pick-up/drop-off location.

RESTROOMS. Permanent public restrooms are located at the Bandstand & Rehoboth Avenue, the Boardwalk & Baltimore Avenue, the Boardwalk & Delaware Avenue, and Grove Park. Mobile restrooms are located at the Beachside Bar & Grill parking lot, 251 Rehoboth Avenue on Saturday only from 8AM until the end of the costume parade.

FIRST AID STATIONS. Sussex County Emergency Medical Services will have a first aid station on Friday, October 27th from 2:30PM-4PM and Sunday, October 29th from 10AM-5PM. It will be located at Rehoboth Avenue and the Boardwalk. There is also a First Aid Station at the Rehoboth Beach Fire Station during all festival hours.

INCLEMENT WEATHER. For information on weather related cancellations and/or postponement of festival events, call the Chamber at 302-227-2233 ext. 12 for recorded updates. Updates will also be posted on the Chamber's Facebook page, plus tune in to local radio stations. Also see schedule of activities on pages 20-25 for activity rain locations. Don't forget to bring your slickers & umbrellas in case of magic rain.

LOST & FOUND. For lost children and/or items, report to the Information Table at the Rehoboth Beach Bandstand for assistance. (Rain Location: RB Fire Station). Unclaimed items are taken to the Rehoboth Beach Police Station at the end of the Festival.

If Traveling From The South (Blue Line: Bethany Beach, Indian River Bridge, Dewey Beach Areas)

Is there satellite parking and are there shuttles from the South? Yes, from the south directly off of Route One/Coastal Highway, parking is available at Oceanside Tower Road in Delaware Seashore State Park. **\$1 or donation** shuttle service (cash collected as riders board shuttle to return to satellite parking locations). Marked with a blue flag. (See map this page).

Is there any other pick-up/drop-off service from the South? Yes, **\$1 or donation** shuttle service (cash collected as riders board shuttle to return to satellite parking locations) pick-up/drop-off at the following Jolly Trolley Oceanside Stops in Dewey Beach marked with blue flags: Dickinson St, Read Ave, Bellevue St, Saulsbury St, & Swedes St. No pick-up/drop-off at Cullen St or Chesapeake St.

Where is the Downtown Rehoboth Beach shuttle pick-up/drop-off if coming from the South? Lake Avenue by the Henlopen Hotel. Marked with a blue flag and signage.

Where do I pick up the shuttle in Downtown Rehoboth Beach to return South? Lake Avenue by the Henlopen Hotel. Marked with a blue flag and signage.

If Traveling From The North (Red Line: Route One-Outlet Areas)

Is there satellite parking and are there shuttles from the North? Yes, from the north directly off of Route One/Coastal Highway, parking is available at the Rehoboth Beach DART Park & Ride (Shuttle Road/273), the Rehoboth Little League Field and the Epworth United Methodist Church. **\$1 or donation** (cash collected as riders board shuttle to return to satellite parking locations). Marked with red flags. (See map this page).

Is there any other pick-up/drop-off service from the North? No.

Where is the Downtown Rehoboth Beach shuttle pick-up/drop-off if coming from the North? Lake Avenue by the Henlopen Hotel. Marked with a red flag and signage.

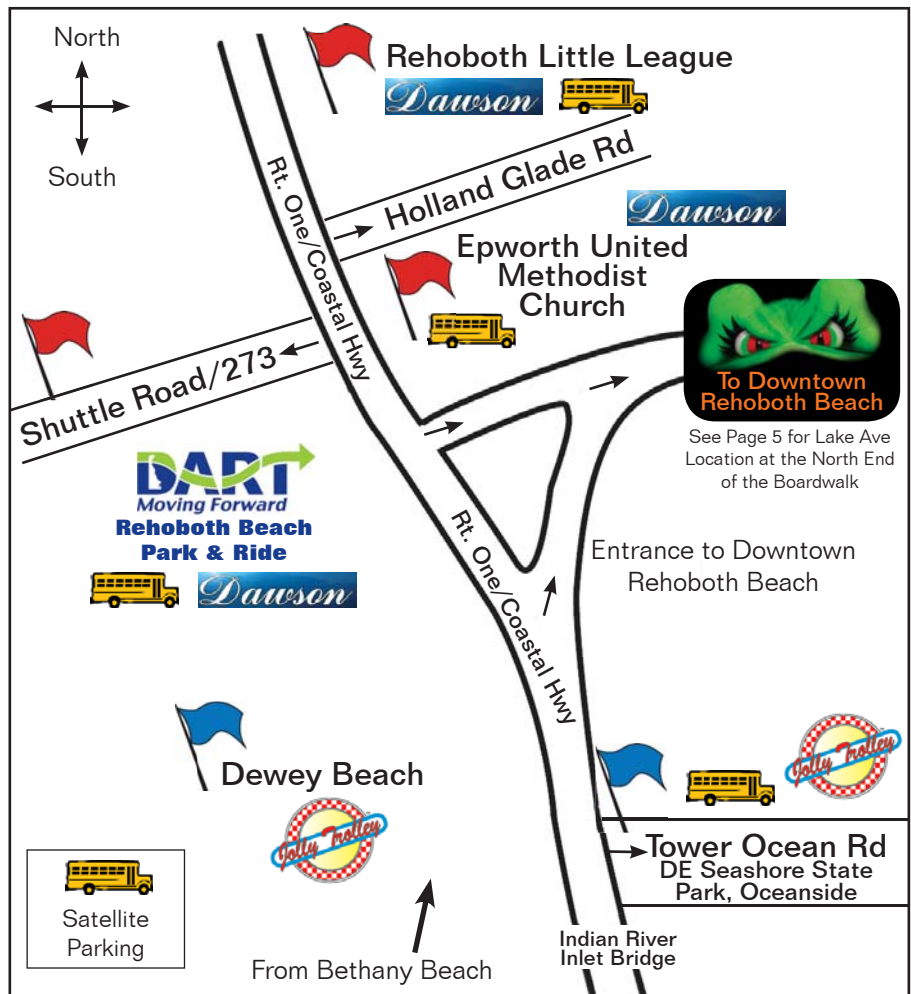

Additional Shuttle Info

What days, times, and how often do the shuttles operate? Shuttles run approximately every 20 minutes on Saturday only, October 28th from 8:00AM - 8:00PM.

Are there handicap accessible shuttles? Some shuttles are handicap accessible. There are no chair lifts on any shuttle. (There is a ½ mile walk down the Boardwalk to the Bandstand area from the Downtown Henlopen Hotel pick-up/drop-off location). If not using the shuttles, there is no official handicap drop-off/pick-up location and it is suggested to be in town no later than 9AM.

Are pets allowed on the shuttles? No.

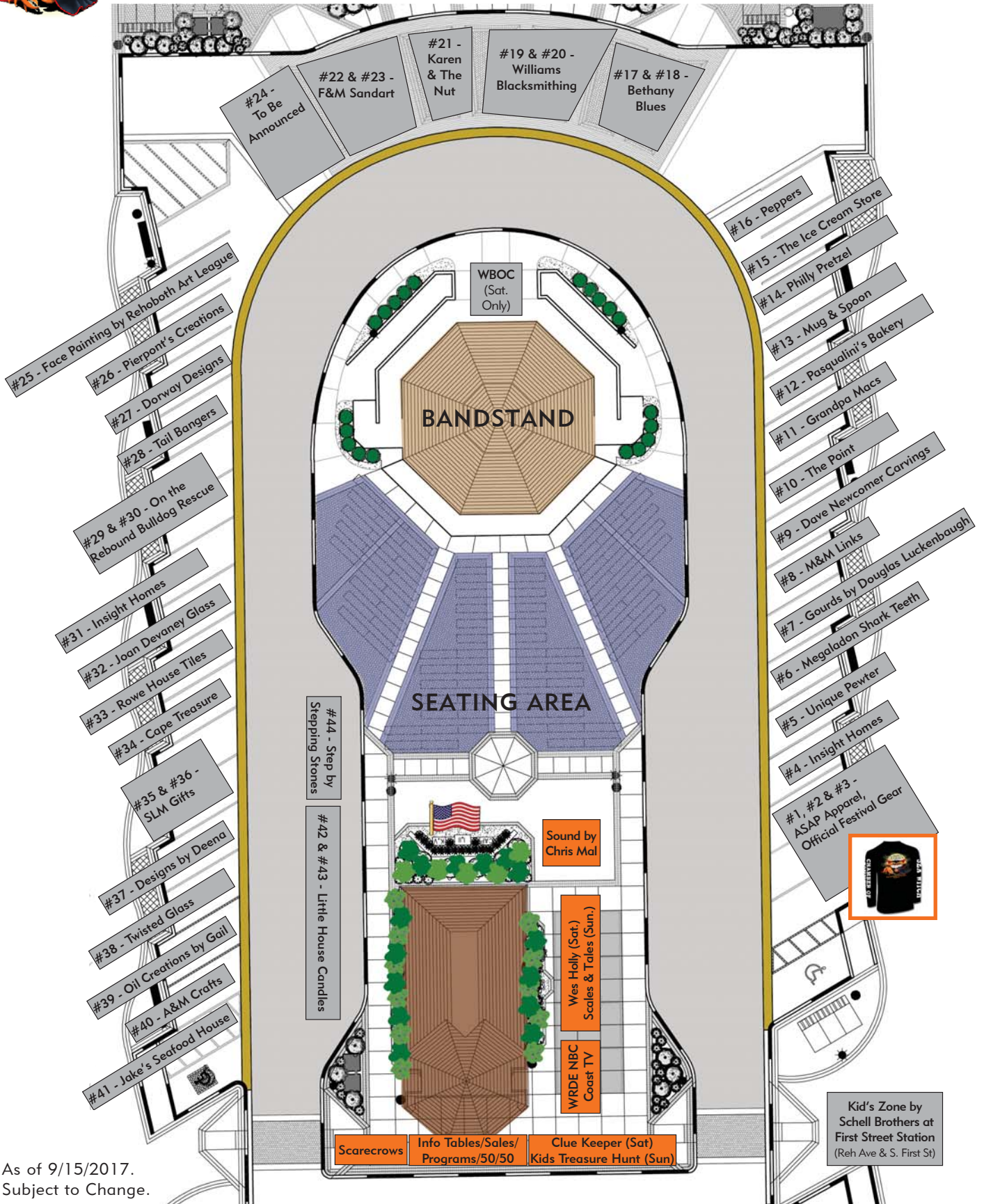
