1

Contact your sponsor.

2

Learn about the procedures in place from your sponsor.

3

Follow sponsor directions.

4

Be sure to contact your employer and landlord if you are evacuating.

5

Take your visa and passport with you.

6

Take your emergency pack with you.

The American Red Cross recommends that the pack contain:

- Water
- Food
- Flashlight
- Battery-powered or hand-crank radio
- Extra batteries
- First aid kit
- Medications (7-day supply) and medical items
- Multi-purpose tool
- Sanitation and personal hygiene items
- Copies of personal documents (medication list and pertinent medical information, proof of address, deed/lease to home, passports, birth certificates, insurance policies)
- Cell phone with chargers
- Family and emergency contact information
- Extra cash
- Emergency blanket
- Map(s) of the area
